## Student Ministry

At camp last month, we decided as a youth group to sponsor a Compassion International child. A generous donor provided the financial support for one year, so our youth group's responsibility is prayer and encouragement. I want to introduce you to Jackline so that you can be praying for her as well.

Jackline Naisiae Kuyuni is six years old and from Kenya. She lives with both her mother, father, and a sibling. Jackline goes to church and has begun school last year. Her chores include running family errands. She loves playing group games with her friends. Jackline's father is occasionally employed as a laborer, and her mother stays at home.

Jackline lives in the community of Ewaso Ngiro, home to approximately 10,000 residents. Typical houses are constructed of wood and have dirt floors. The primary ethnic group is Maasai and the most commonly spoken language is Maa. The regional diet consists of maize and beans. Common health problems in this area include malaria, HIV/AIDS, typhoid and upper respiratory tract infections. Thankfully, Jackline is healthy. Most adults in Ewaso Ngiro are unemployed but some work as day laborers and earn the equivalent of \$20 per month. This community needs affordable education and training in livelihood skills.

Please be in prayer for Jackline. Specifically, pray for Jackline's health. While to date, she is healthy, there are many diseases in Africa that may endanger her health. Pray also for Jackline's education. Kenya is ahead of the rest of Africa in their educational standards, but many smaller communities like the one that Jackline lives in are behind in literacy. Also pray for Jackline's salvation. She does attend church regularly, but we do not have word whether or not she has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Pray for Jackline's family as well. Pray for their health, work, and salvation.
