Student Ministry

Coulrophobia is the fear of clowns. There are 5 words that mean "fear of darkness" or "fear of the dark" including lygophobia. Pentheraphobia is the fear of mother-in-laws. And my favorite, peladophobia is the fear of bald people. (I'm hoping some of our youth will get that one.) There is a name for every type of fear you can imagine. (Omphalophobia is the fear of belly buttons.) But one thing I cannot find the on the phobia list is the fear of evangelizing.

In reality, I don't think anyone has a medical condition that would necessitate the word "evangelophobia", but it is a legitimate fear among Christians. When it comes to sharing our faith, we just simply will not do it. Some of us are afraid of rejection. Others are afraid of failure. Still others are just afraid of speaking to others in general about anything. But Scripture does not allow us the option to be "to afraid" to witness. In Isaiah 41:10, God says to Isaiah, "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." That same promise applies to you and me.

On September 16th, we are testing some of our fears. This year's Fear Factor for our youth will be more about challenges than critters. (Remember Alice, the 8 foot snake? She brought out some ophidiophobia, fear of snakes.) While we will have some animals, Alice will not be returning this year. (Maybe next time.) This event is designed to draw community students into Northside. If we have 100 students, Brother Mac will face the 10 bags of doom.

Also, S.O.D. classes are starting on September 13th. Instead of meeting before church on Sunday evenings, we will be meeting for worship with the entire congregation and be dismissed during the message time.
