## Student Ministry



It is estimated that every person every day makes around 20,000 voluntary decisions. From the decision to get out of bed, walk to the kitchen, wear a certain color shirt, or when to put your socks on, decisions are made constantly. Some decisions have very little impact on our lives. As I write this I am wearing a white shirt, which no one should care about. Some affect our day to day actions. If I decide to eat Mexican late tonight, it will affect how I sleep (especially if I follow it with something rich and sweet!) And some decisions affect our entire lives.

The Bible gives us guidance on making decisions. Ephesians 5:15 says, "Be very careful, then, how you live – not as unwise but as wise." We all know we need to make wise decisions, but how do we know what to choose? And how do we know which decisions will affect us short term and which will affect us long term?

This year's Disciple Now theme is "Choose." From Friday, October 23rd to Sunday, October 25th, our students will experience a study in making wise choices. The four sessions will include "Choosing Faith," "Consequences," "Choose your Reaction", and "What is Your Purpose?" Also included in the weekend will be team building activities to help unify our youth group.

We need help from you to put this event on. Students will be staying in local houses on Friday night and Saturday night. We need families to volunteer their homes for 6-8 students and 1-2 adults to stay in. We also need families or individuals that would cook for 6-8 students plus 1-2 adults per house.
